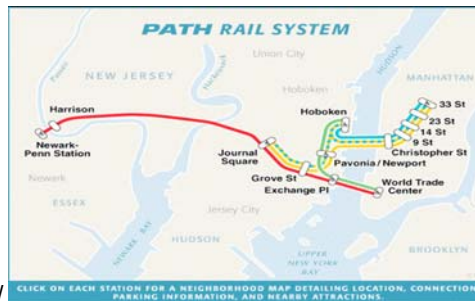

Take a Newark-bound train and get off at 1st stop which is Grove Street and transfer to 33rd Street train, which stops at Hoboken.

From Hoboken to hotel at Exchange Place:

Take Journal Square bound train and get off at 1st stop which is Grove Street and transfer to WTC train to next stop which is Exchange Place.
